Winwhistle and Sunny View - fence erected that may have interfered with the County Council's verge. MH will have a look.

Fence gone up at Branch's house. Should be under the same rules as the Mackenzie's. MH asked for an email.

Paul McKenzie - 40mph sign is overgrown in Fenn St. Clerk to ask the landowner to trim the hedge.
