People and Place Plans update The People and Place Plan (PPP) forms part of the Levelling Up and Regeneration Bill which is due a third reading in Parliament before the summer recess. Further details should emerge regarding the statutory weighting of the document, the level of evidence required and how the scheme may be funded. MSDC is one of six councils in England that won a bid to trial the new scheme to help Local Authorities and communities develop a more community-led approach to planning, a soft touch approach to neighbourhood plans.
Getting acquainted and updated	Since my last report I have been getting to know our Sustainable Travel Officer, Locality Officer, Biodiversity officer and Town Centre co-ordinator to find out what they can offer the ward of Debenham. I will be focussing on improving Walking and Cycling routes and heading up a pilot for electric buses. To improve our surroundings by creating beautiful and diverse green areas of the ward. I will also be looking to improve awareness of local business throughout the ward. Should you need any support or advice and even funding on any of these topics please get pop me an email. We already have a number of groups in the ward who are working on these things for where they live and it would be great see other villages getting involved and obtaining opportunities for the residents.
Planning & Development	Electric Vehicle Charging Points Babergh and Mid Suffolk have been awarded a £300k grant from the Office for Zero Emissions Vehicles to install 28 new 22kW EV charging points in several carparks including most of the councilowned carparks in Stowmarket.
